Issue raised	Latest position
Issue No. 3: Problems of Departmental Catering Staff working on deemed deputation under IRCTC.	Instructions on repatriation of 188 Deemed Deputationist Officials (DDOs) to Railways from IRCTC, have been issued vide Board's letter No. E(NG)-I-2003/TR/10Pt. III dated 02.03.2015. (The issue may please be closed).
Issue No. 7: HOER- Running Staff and other Safety categories. It was agreed that a High Power Committee with an eminent Judge of High Court would be constituted to look into all the above issues. Committee has not been set up till date.	The views of Zonal Railways, concerned Directorates of the Railway Board and Federations on the recommendations of High Power Committee have been compiled and put up to Board for a final decision.
