56/2006: Indian Railway Tourism and Catering Corporation – Catering staff on deputation.

The matter will be taken up later for discussion on the request of the Federation.

25/2011: Selection for J.E. Pay Band Rs.9300-Rs.34800 – Eligibility thereof.

In the light of discussions held, matter will be re-examined in consultation with Technical Directorates, so as to put up further for a decision of the Board.

42/2016: Compassionate grounds appointment to daughter-in-law of the deceased railway employee.

The Federation drew attention to the agreement reached as contained in the PNM/AIRF's minutes dated 16.01.2017 and demanded that the same should be implemented. The matter shall be looked into in the light of the above.

55/2018: Granting of three sets of Privilege Passes annually to all the Non-Gazetted Staff on appointment in the Railways.

Official Side indicated that the demand involves amendment of statutory provisions of Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 (Second Edition-1993) and it requires sufficient justification. The Federation agreed to furnish detailed justifications for re-examination of the case.

The matter will be re-examined for consideration.
