Dear Comrades,

Sub: Massive Demonstration on the Parliament – Calling upon the Railwaymen and other Central Government Employees for an Indefinite Strike from 06:00 hrs. on 23rd November, 2015

At the outset I must congratulate all our affiliates in the Zonal Railways, Production Units and MTP Railway, Kolkata, for their massive participation in the demonstration, held before the Parliament today, i.e. on **28th April, 2015**.

The rallies started from the AIRF Office, 4 State Entry Road, New Delhi, at 08:45 hrs. and assembled at the Parliament Street. More than one lakh Railwaymen and other Central Government Employees participated in it with great enthusiasm.

Resolution(photocopy enclosed), calling upon all the Railwaymen and other Central Government Employees to make “**Indefinite Strike**”, commencing from **06:00 hrs. on 23rd November, 2015**, in the **Railways, Defence, Postal and other Central Government Services**, a grand success, was moved by **Com. K.K.N. Kutty**, President, Confederation of Central Government Employees’ & Workers, which was supported by all the leaders of **All India Railwaymen’s Federation, National Federation of Indian Railwaymen, All India Defence Employees Federation, National Defence Workers’ Federation, National Federation of Postal Employees, Confederation of Central Government Employees’ & Workers**.

Entire proceedings were conducted by **Com. Shiva Gopal Mishra**, General Secretary AIRF, who is also Convener of the National Joint Council of Action.

Com. Rakhal Das Gupta, President, **Com. N. Kanniah**, Working President and **Com. Harbhajan Singh Sidhu**, Asstt. General Secretary, AIRF, delivered illuminating; speeches, calling upon formation of total unity to make the “**Indefinite Strike**” a grand success.

The demonstration concluded at 13:30 hrs.

Thereafter, leaders of the NJCA submitted a memorandum, addressed to Hon'ble Speaker, Lok Sabha, containing **10-point Charter of Demands**, seeking her intervention in the settlement of these demands.

Immediate task before us is to convey message to all the Railwaymen, preferably through "**May Day**" rally, and in case the same is not possible(as most of the leaders will be *en-route* on their return journey), immediately after May Day Meeting, well planned meetings should be held, calling upon the Railwaymen to prepare for a decisive struggle from **06:00 hrs. of 23rd November, 2015.**

It is expected that our affiliates will draw out subsequent programmes, as discussed in the meeting of the AIRF Standing Committee, held on **27th April, 2015 in New Delhi, to bring the Railway wheels to bringing at halt.**
