Record Note of Discussions held by EDE(N) with AIRF on 14.05.2015 on PNM/AIRF Item No.19-A/2013: Absorption of contract para-medical staff in Railway services.

It was explained to the Federation that arrangement of contractual para-medical staff is purely a temporary measure to overcome the shortage of staff in essential medical services till the regular staff are available. Further, the issue was earlier raised by AIRF and was examined and considered by the Board in consultation with Finance and Health Dte. of this Ministry but the same could not be agreed to.

Federation, however, mentioned that as has been in the case of Teachers, regularization of contract para-medical staff be done separately through RRB. It was agreed to examine the request of the Federation.
